Royal Park residents please note:

As of August 1, 2009 the cost of water has gone up. Fort Lauderdale is raising the rate for water and sewer services a whopping 20 percent. Unfortunately Oakland Park gets their water from Fort Lauderdale, therefore we at Royal Park will be effected by this increase.

The Board of Directors has been working so hard to not only work within but under our budget hoping to be able to keep next year's maintenance fees the same as this year. But we need your help.

Please check your faucets and shower heads for leaks. Is your toilet constantly running? All it may need is a new flapper, or maybe you might

think about a new water efficient toilet.

You may also want to check if any of the shutoff valves under the sink or toilet are leaking.

Use your dishwasher when it is fully loaded, not for a few dishes and glasses. Washing your car is okay, but how about once a month or every other week. We have some residents that wash their car 2-3 times a week. For those wondering, our sprinkler system uses canal water.

Furthermore, if you are going away for more than a week then make sure you turn your main water supply connection in the water heater closet off by turning the lever down and also take the plug off the water heater.

This additional cost must be shared by all of Royal Park's residents. Therefore it is imperative that we all do as much as we can to keep our water bills as low as we can so the Board can try to cover the higher rates with as minimal effect to our residents.



Dumpster Dilemmas & Recycling - Naim Naqi

Many residents continue to throw large and small boxes, without breaking them down in the dumpster. It has been noticed many times that a couple of large boxes start the mountain of trash resulting in an overflow capacity. Just remember, each building has 32 units and only one dumpster so please be considerate of our cleaning crew and maintenance staff who spend a lot of time each week keeping the dumpster rooms clean.

There is also a very important issue which must be seriously taken by residents who live higher than the first floor. Every Monday and Thursday when the dumpsters are placed outside for pickup - residents continue to through boxes through the chute which sometimes get stuck

resulting in backing up of garbage. Please note it takes several hours to clean the dumpster rooms from the overflow of rubbish and return the dumpsters back in the room.

Residents, please go down and dispose off the garbage properly in the dumpster during this period and also remember that paint cans with paint does not belong in dumpster room nor does furniture, discarded large items, old appliances, carpets and rugs – these all should be properly disposed off at the fenced off area by the maintenance shed in front of building 117.

When someone does remodeling in your apartment you are responsible to make sure they remove or dispose off the items appropriately.

disposal by the weight. Each time the garbage truck comes in it weighs our trash and bill accordingly, therefore, it is utmost important to **RECYCLE**. We have green recycling bins throughout the complex and marked newspapers for papers and magazines and comingle for plastic and glass etc. The more we recycle the more we will continue to keep our maintenance low.

Recycling Fast Facts:

Broward County recycles approximately 862,000 tons of materials, or on average 990 ponds per person per year. By recycling we save energy, resources, and help create a healthier environment!

Broward County's waste-to-energy plants are a source of renewable energy. They turn your household trash into green energy – enough to power more than 75,000 homes and businesses in our community each day!

One successful story is that of Vista View Park, formerly the Davie land-fill, was closed in 1987 and turned into a wonderful green space. It features horse trails, bicycling and picnic shelters, among other amenities, for the enjoyment of Broward County residents.

Coming soon will be the new Single-Stream Recycling Bins where you can dispose All-In-One paper, plastic bottles, metal and glass recyclables – till further notice please continue to use the designated bins.

Whether you are disposing garbage

or recycling, use common sense to help you do the job effectively, for example make sure the garbage bag is tied safely and not torn in which case you may want to use a double bag otherwise it will attract pesky critters who may find a way back to your apartment. Similarly sort out the recycling items in advance for proper disposal.

If you get a chance, take your kids to see 'WONDERFUL WORLD OF WASTE EXHIBITION' - at the Museum of Discovery & Science, 401 SW 2nd St., Ft. Lauderdale.

.Kids can get down and dirty at the Museum of Discovery and Science in Fort Lauderdale where the "Wonderful World of Waste" interactive exhibit teaches them about how waste-to-energy plants turn household garbage into electricity. Kids turn a few cranks and garbage (simulated by a grey block) is carried on a conveyor belt where a pretend fire lights up, steam forms, and a turbine fan starts working, providing electricity to the house that produced the garbage.

Recycling commercials and a 13-minute video "All About Garbage" play continuously throughout the day.

100 Years Ago - Imagine Life in the Year 1909



In the last issue on page 7 we touched briefly on lifestyle in 2009

What a difference a Century makes – It is one hundred years ago – The year is 1909

Be ready to go back in time and check out some basic facts of life at the time and some statistics.

The average life expectancy was 47 years.
Only 14% of the homes had a bath tub
Only 8% of the homes had a telephone.
There were only 8,000 cars and only 144 miles of paved roads.
The maximum speed limit in most cities was 10mph
(lower than some residents drive thru Royal Park gate!)
More than 95% of all births took place at home.
Most women only washed their hair once a month, and
used borax and egg yolks for shampoo.
The American flag had only 45 stars.
The population of Las Vegas, Nevada was only 30!
Two out of every 10 adults couldn't read or write
Only 6% of all American had graduated from high school.
18% of households had at least one full time servant or domestic help.

Wages

The average wage in 1909 was 22 cents per hour.

The average worker made between \$200 and \$400 per year.

A competent accountant could expect to earn \$2,000 per year.

A dentist \$2,500 and a mechanical engineer about \$5,000 a year.

Ninety percent of all doctors had no college education! Instead, they attended so-called medical schools, many of which were condemned in the press as substandard.

Marijuana, heroin and morphine were all available over the counter at the local corner drugstores (Wow! The good old days!) Back then pharmacists said, "Heroin clears the complexion, gives buoyancy to the mind, regulates the stomach and bowels, and is, in fact, a perfect guardian of health."

(Unfortunately half a million present day jailed inmates still believe this to be true – but no one trust them!)

Food Prices:

Sugar cost 4 cents a pound. Eggs were 14 cents a dozen Coffee was 15 cents a pound.

summer of 2006, according to the Standard & Poor's/ Case-Shiller 20-city index.


Prices rose from April in 13 of the cities tracked, notably Cleveland, Dallas and Boston.


