Cost of Christmas: \$18,920

If Christmas feels a bit more expensive this year, you can blame it on the pear tree -- as well as the lords a-leaping. the ladies dancing and the drummers drumming.

The annual PNC Christmas Price Index, based on the cost of the items in "The 12 Days of Christmas," rose 3.1% this year, with the sharpest increase coming from the 44% jump in pear tree prices.

"Robust commercial construction is sparking landscapers' demand for ornamental trees, such as the species of pear used in the survey," said Jeff Kleintop, chief investment strategist for PNC Wealth Management, which creates the annual survey.

What didn't occur....NO HURRICANES AND NO ASSESMENTS....what a great year!


Here's hoping 2007 is as good a year with all residents working together to improve our property as well as our way of life at Royal Park.

But it was low unemployment -and, consequently, higher labor costs -- that really put the bite in the holidays this year.

"The Christmas Price Index reflects trends in the broader economy," said Kleintop. "After years of stagnation, wages for skilled workers, including the song's dancers and musicians, have increased as the labor market has tightened. Also, a decline in the housing market has dampened demand for luxury goods, such as gold rings."

According to the 22nd annual survey, the cost of "The 12 Days of Christmas" is \$18,920 in 2006, compared with \$18,349 in 2005. Gift prices mirrored the U.S. government's Consumer Price Index -- a widely used measure of

inflation calculated by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Labor costs for dancers, drummers

The largest dollar increase this year came from rising labor costs, which exceeded the rate of inflation for the first time in years.

According to Philadanco, the Philadelphia Dance Company, the cost of nine ladies dancing was \$4,759, 4% more than in 2006. The women's wage increase outstripped those of their performing peers: The cost of lords a-leaping rose 3%, while the musicians -- the drummers drumming and the pipers piping -- earned 3.4% more than in 2005.

Maids a-milking, who are paid the minimum wage, were the only service providers not to see an increase this year. The federal minimum wage has been set at \$5.15 per hour since 1997. Inflation since 1996 has steadily eroded the purchasing power of the hourly minimum, which would be worth \$4.04 in 1996 dollars.

For the birds: Flat prices

The price of the partridge (as well as that of turtle doves, French hens, geese and swans) was flat this year, according to The Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Gardens, as the cost of fuel to ship the birds leveled off. The avian exception was calling birds, which were purchased at a national pet store chain and increased 20%.

Gold rings also stayed constant this year despite a cost increase in the raw material -- gold -- because of softening demand for luxury goods.

"A slowing residential real estate market is making people feel less wealthy this year," said Kleintop. "Investors have been buying gold as an inflation hedge and prices per ounce remain much higher than last year," he added. "This may put pressure on profit margins at retail jewelers, who have not been able to pass along the increased cost to consumers."

Oakland Park BARK PARK has been completed, and now 'Open for Business'. A previously dismally visual and appearing site has been transformed into a well designed. attractive and attracting venue. On any given day, local citizens, and those from further away have congregated to enjoy time out with the family, which includes the whole family.

A new popular site for rest and relaxation, a host of frequent visitors ensure it receives lots of use. The other day I stopped by and all the parking spots were taken, and there were dogs of every breed, size and

ROYAL PALM PARK (across the street from our entrance) is nearly completed. The huge catch basins they buried to stop flooding at our entranceway have been hooked up and the sod replaced. Next to come will be the planting of several Royal Palm trees on both sides of the

street; extending out from our entranceway, leading all the way up to the little grove of Oaks next to the entrance of Easterlin Park. Additional Royal Palms will be planted starting at the entranceway of the parking lot, extending to the wetlands area.

Royal Park has received a Broward Beautiful Grant for \$9.466 (matching grant) as well as having received the Broward County Permit(s) to proceed. The project will start with the entranceway grant portion as soon as the Royal Palm trees are planted. This project will involve beautifying the entranceway on both sides of the drive with native plants and trees.

Many of the plantings currently there will be transplanted to bare spots where WILMA destroyed trees & foliage. Meanwhile, the "crowning touch" will be the reactivating of the fountain that used to be on the east side of the entranceway.

Jewish Apple Cake

- 5 TBSP Sugar
- 2 tsp. Cinnamon
- 4 med size apples (pealed and sliced)
 Mix items above and set aside.
- 2 cups sugar
- 3 cups flour
- 3 tsp. Baking powder

Make a hole in the flour mix and add:

- 4 eggs
- 1/2 cup OJ
- 1 cup oil
- 2 1/2 tsp. Vanilla
- 1. Mix slowly; then beat for 5 minutes.
- 2. Grease and flour tube pan.
- Pour 1/2 the batter in pan, arrange 1/2 apple close together on top and pour remaining batter.
- 4. Top it with the other 1/2 of the apples. Bake at 350° for 1 hour. (Check with a toothpick).

Hanukkah: Festival of Lights

The Menorah has 9 candle holders. Eight for the eight days & one for the Shamash (the helper), which stands taller than the others and off to the side. When we light the candles we also recite the blessings...



Kiswahili and Kwanzaa

Origin of Kwanzaa

Kwanzaa is an African-American celebration initiated by Dr. Karenga as both a way to celebrate the New Year and a reminder of the history of black communities in the United States. It is patterned on the African celebration of harvest during which tribute is paid to the ancestors and to God while at the same time praying for another benevolent year. The celebration has also become an opportunity for most African-American communities to teach younger generations about African culture, rituals and language. Kiswahili is the privileged language for the seven-day festivities.

Importance of Kiswahili

Kiswahili is the language privileged as the main means of communication of the rituals. The word itself, **Kwanzaa**, is the Kiswahili word for beginning. It comes from the verb *ku-anza*, that is, to begin. It indicates thus the firm determination of a community to begin a new year of commitment, hard work and fulfillment that require collective effort. The week of celebration is also an opportunity to highlight **seven principles** that serve as the *building blocks* of Ubiquity. They represent the aspiration and the goals each community sets itself collectively and its members individually. These seven principles are the following:

 Umoja (Unity). This is to strive for a principles and harmonious togetherness in the family, community, nation and world African community.

- Kijichagulia (self-Determination). To define ourselves, name ourselves, create for ourselves and speak for ourselves instead of being defined, named, created for and spoken for by others.
- Ujima (Collective Work and Responsibility). To build and maintain our community together and makes our sisters' and brothers' problems our problems and solve them together.
- Ujamaa (Cooperative Economics). To build our own businesses, control the economics of our own community and share in all its work and wealth.
- Nia (Purpose). To make our collective vocation the building and developing of our community in order to restore our people to their traditional greatness.
- Kuumba (Creativity). To do always as much as we can in the way we can in order to leave our community more beautiful and beneficial than when we inherited it.
- Imani (Faith). To believe with all our heart in our Creator, our people, our parents, our teachers, our leaders and the righteousness and victory of our struggle.

Kwanzaa and Christmas

Kwanzaa is celebrated in many African-American communities in December. It has become one of the most visible celebrations beside Christmas and Hanukkah during the holiday season.

On the first night of Hanukkah we add the 'Shehechiyanu' prayer, which expresses appreciation at reaching this occasion once again.

Baruch Ata Adonai, Eloheinu melech ha-olam, shehechiyanu vâe kimanu v'higianu lazman hazeh.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God and Ruler of the World, for giving us life, for sustaining us and for enabling us to reach this season.

The traditional miracle of this holiday is when the Maccabees, the victorious Jewish army, rededicated the temple in Jerusalem they only found enough oil to light the Eternal Light for one day. The oil lasted 8 days, and it was at this time only when they found more oil. During this holiday we eat foods cooked in oil such as Potato Latkas & Sufganiyot.
