With 110 company-owned restaurants in 15 states Sweet Tomatoes has earned the reputation as #1 in fresh produce and salads, made from-scratch soups, hot tossed pastas, freshly baked breads and muffins, fresh fruit, frozen yogurt, and more.

I am not an enthusiast of all you can eat places since quality is compromised with the profusion of quantity but here the food is light and healthy besides how fat you can get eating greens and fruit. The food is not entirely vegetarian as the name



As the case made its way into court, the judge looked over the paperwork at the hearing and commented:


"I don't know how I'm going to decide this case, but it appears from the paperwork, we have a brothel owner who believes in the power of prayer and we have an entire church that doesn't."


